

Medical form

All students wishing to travel with the robotics team to tournaments are required to have a current medical form on file with Mr. Colon.

- New Stuyvesant students, including freshman, have already provided this form to the school as part of the admission process.
- Athletes on school teams have medical forms on file. (check the date to make sure the form is current)
- If a student has traveled with the school recently (for example, on the college tour) a medical form was previously filed.

Students with the above situations should request a copy of their form from the school nurse and personally deliver the form to Mr. Colon.

Any other student must make an appointment for a physical exam and have a new form completed and signed by the physician. It may be possible to see a doctor at school for free. Speak to the school nurse for more information.

Note that robotics students who traveled last year with the team need a new form—the old one will expire and will not be acceptable. Medical forms are valid for only one year.

Don't delay. All students **MUST** have a current medical form on file with Mr. Colon or they will not be allowed to travel to competitions with the robotics team. No exceptions can be made.
