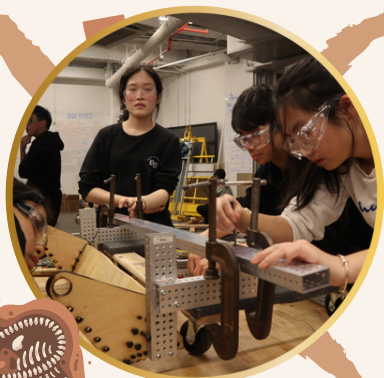
Kickoff Day 2

Mechanical Engineering

Mechanical Engineering worked on designing, machining, and testing different mechanisms such as the shooter, the intake, and the hopper. They also have made great progress on field construction, finishing the bump and trench, adding a hoop to the hub, and starting to work on the tower.



Software Engineering

Software Engineering did several tests with Mechanical Engineering and researched programs for different mechanisms on the robot like the shooter and intake. Our software engineering department also continued their rookie education curriculum by motivating rookies with engaging lessons that incorporated previous robot designs.

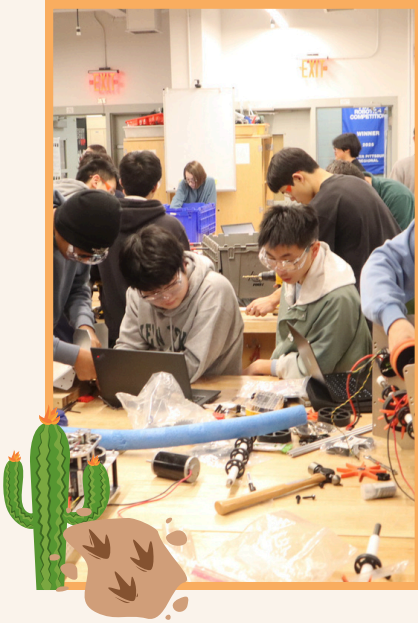
Business
